By Train

Ballia is a major railway station in Uttar Pradesh, situated on the North Eastern Railway line. It is well-connected to major cities such as Varanasi, Gorakhpur, Delhi, Kolkata, and Lucknow.

- * **Nearest Railway Station:** Ballia Junction (Station Code: BUI)
- * **Distance to the University:** Approximately 12km
