About the University:

Jananayak Chandrashekhar University, Ballia (henceforth JNCU) was established on 22 December 2016. Ballia, the great capital of King Ball and the prodigious seat of penance of the great devotee Maharishi Bhrigu, is the birthplace of great souls like Mangal Pandey (the first martyr of India's First Independence Movement in 1857), Chittu Pandey (the first district magistrate in the wake of Quit India Movement, 1942); Jayaprakash Narayan (popularly known as J. P. or Lok Nayak emerged against the backdrop of the 1975 Emergency) and Chandrashekhar, the former Prime Minister of India, famous as Jananayak and Yuva Turk leader. Ballia has also been the inordinate place of litterateurs like Acharya Parashuram Chaturvedi, Hajari Prasad Dwivedi, Amarkant, Padmashri Krishna Bihari Mishra and Kedarnath Singh, etc. In addition to the above, it is delightfully shared that the Ballia is a land of "living legends" who are deponents of this glorious tradition of knowledge production who belong to the seat of learning and disseminate the same globally by being an indispensable part of Ballia Diaspora.

The JNCU, sprawling over 54 acres of lush green campus near Suraha Taal, the bonafide of approx. 20,000 migratory birds, was established with an objective to impart quality education to the students who hail from the rural segments of the district Ballia. The university also focuses to provide career-oriented courses to the students to enable them to be at par with national/international standards. The university offers various courses related to the discipline of Arts, Sciences, Commerce, Law and Agriculture Sciences, moderated by 19 departments. By fastering networking opportunities and collaborations, the program serves as a catalyst for advancing research and technological development.

In addition, this transformative initiative is a strategic step toward enhancing innovation, protecting intellectual property, and driving economic and technological progress. It is an invaluable resource for building a robust ecosystem of innovation and IP awareness.
