Notice for Admission in Ph.D.

Online applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to Ph.D. programme through Entrance Test in various subjects running in university/campus and its affiliated colleges upto 05 June 2019.

Online application, general rules, eligibility and other details regarding the Research Entrance Test (RET-2019) is available on university website www.jncu.ac.in.

Eligibility for Entrance Test

A candidate applying for RET-2019 must hold a postgraduate degree in the concerned subject with a minimum 55% marks or Equivalent Grade in 7 point scale of UGC. A relaxation of 5% in minimum marks shall be given to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Differentially abled candidates. Candidates appearing for final year/final semester of their postgraduate degree examination are also eligible to appear for the admission process subject to the fulfillment of minimum eligibility criteria in the final result which is required at the time of admission.

Instructions for On-line Application

1. The eligible candidates who are willing to participate in the admission process shall have to apply on-line through university website: www.jncu.ac.in.
2. An application fee for Research entrance test -2019 (RET 2019) will be Rs. 1200/- for General and OBC candidate and for Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and differentially abled candidates fee will be Rs. 800/-, Bank transaction charges will be charged as applicable.
3. Registration fee for Online application of RET-2019 will be submitted online through Net-Banking/NEFT or Debit/Credit-Card. Only after the fee submission, the applicants can fill the online application. Printout of the pay-in-slip of Bank along with the print out of the application form is to be taken by the applicant.
4. The candidate will be solely responsible for all the entries made by him in the on-line application. If the candidate conceals or misrepresents any fact in the entries, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will be liable to be debarred from admission in the University.
5. Entries made by the Applicant in the form will be considered final and no subsequent request for change(s) or modification (s) in the same will be entertained.
6. Admission to Ph.D. programme will be through a entrance test The Entrance Test will be conducted in one question paper based on Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)/ OMR Pattern containing the following:

<u>Part – I:</u> General awareness & Academic aptitude	50 Questions	100 Marks
<u>Part – II:</u> Subject Specific & Research Methodology	50 Questions	100 Marks
Total	100 Questions	200 Marks

The duration of the test will be of 2 Hours (120 mins.)

- a. There will not be any negative marking.

- b. The minimum qualifying marks for General/OBC candidates will be 40 percent and 36 percent for the candidates belonging to the scheduled caste, scheduled tribe and differentially abled categories.
7. Candidate has to appear in a Research Entrance Test (RET-2019) to be conducted by the university. Candidate who had qualified NET/JRF/GATE examination will also appear in RET-2019. If a candidate fails to apply on-line, he/she will not be considered for admission.
8. Weightage to the following candidates will be given as per the details given below:

- Maximum weightage will be of 15 marks only.
9. The RET-2019 for various Ph.D. programmes, will be conducted at different centers/colleges of Ballia only.
10. Candidates are advised to fill up the Answer - OMR sheet carefully during examination.
11. The candidate must bring his/her admit card and at least one photo identity proof to appear in entrance test.
12. Based on the marks obtained in the entrance test, Subject wise merit list will be prepared for each category. The list of successful candidate will be displayed on the official website of the University www.jncu.ac.in.
13. On the basis of marks obtained in the test the final merit list will be prepared subject wise, category wise according to the available seats with the Research supervisors. As per the final merit list the selected candidates will be informed by Speed/ Registered Post. Candidates will also be informed at their e-mail address and mobile number (if provided).
14. Candidates will have to register themselves with the Jananayak Chandrasekhar University with in the stipulated time for the compulsory

semester course work of Ph.D. programme to be conducted at various approved Research centers of the university.

15. The candidates who will be given admission will have to deposit the prescribed Compulsory course work fee of Rs. 25000/- (Rs. 20000 for Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and differentially abled) in the university with in the period of 1 week, failing which waitlisted candidates will be invited.

Syllabus for Research Entrance Test

Syllabus of RET-2019 will be similar to that prescribed for NET/JRF Examination of University Grants Commissions (UGC), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), Indian Council of Agriculture Research (ICAR) which may be seen from respective websites
